## REPLY:

The National Commissioner of the South African Police Service (SAPS) was vetted and in possession of a Top Security Clearance, issued by the State Security Agency (SSA). The Clearance Certificate expired on 31 December 2018 and the National Commissioner applied for the renewal thereof and re-vetting, in December 2018. The vetting process by the SSA, is still ongoing.

In terms of guidelines for the appointment, the National Commissioner should have either a valid Security Clearance or proof of application for such at the time of appointment, of which the latter is applicable in this case.
