- (2) what specific actions have been taken during the period 16 October 2020 and 31 December 2020 to (a) deal with the large percentage of vehicles out of service and (b) increase the number of operational SA Police Service vehicles?

- o A Global Financial Authority is used to purchase bulk stock.
- o Artisans from other garages are deployed to the problematic main garages.

(2)(b) To increase the number of the South African Police Service (SAPS) operational vehicles, the following actions have been taken:

- o A situational analysis was conducted, in terms of mechanical transport, to compile an operational risk and mitigation strategy.
- o The Financial Authority (FA) must be granted within two working days.
