1. Whether the SA Post Office has identified the non-core properties that will be sold as part of its realignment project, if not, what is the position in this regards, if so,
2. Whether he will furnish Ms T Bodlani with a list of the properties that have already been identified; if not, why not; if so, what are the relevant details;
3. What is the expected revenue from the sale exercise?

REPLY:

- (1) Several non-core properties were previously identified to be sold or redeveloped, prior to the SA Post Office being placed in business rescue on 10 July 2023. A business rescue plan is in the process of being developed which will consider the list of non-core properties to be sold or redeveloped and where required, amend such list.
- (2) As indicated in (1) above, the list of non-core properties is in the process of evaluation, and it will be finalised as part of business rescue plan. Following approval of the business rescue plan, the list will be made available.
- (3) Non-core properties will undergo an independent valuation process prior to being made available for sale. SAPO is unable to disclose the expected revenue to be generated from the sale of these non-core properties.
