## 439. Mr N Singh (IFP) to ask the Minister of Police:

- (1) Whether any progress has been made with the building of a new police station complex in Magabheni-Umkomaas in KwaZulu-Natal; if not, why not; if so, what is the latest progress report in this regard;
- (2)(a) what are the reasons for the removal of a satellite police station at Magabheni and (b) by what date will it be reinstated?

#### REPLY:

- (1) The building of a new police station complex in Magabheni-Umkomaas in KwaZulu-Natal has not been initaited. The construction of a new satellite police station is priority number 78 on the User Asset Management Plan (U-AMP) and is, therefore, not prioritized within the current Medium Term Expenditure Framework (MTEF). Only the top 10 priorities, per province, are activated during the MTEF Cycle.
- (2)(a) The Magabheni Satellite Police Station is closed, due to it burning down on 24 April 2018, as per Umkomaas CAS 235/04/2018.
- (b) There is no date available currently, for the reinstatement of the Magabheni Satellite Police Station, as the facility is a non-devolved facility and the repairs are vested under the auspices of the National Department of Public Works and Infrastructure.
